

A substantial reduction in Fund assets (since its most recently completed fiscal year), whether caused by market conditions or significant redemptions or both, will likely cause total operating expenses (as a percentage of Fund assets) to become higher than those shown. A Note about Risk: The Fund invests in underlying funds that may engage in a variety of investment strategies involving certain risks; the Fund is subject to the particular risks of an underlying fund in proportion to a respective investment. Because the Fund maintains a balanced allocation among equity and fixed-income funds, it will be affected by risks associated with equity and fixed-income markets, as well as the financial condition and prospects of issuers in which the underlying funds invest. Barron's rankings are based on asset weighted returns in funds in five categories: general equity, world equity (including international and global portfolios), mixed asset (which invest in stocks, bonds and other securities), taxable bond, and tax-exempt (each a "Barron's ranking category"). Rankings also take into account an individual fund's performance within its Lipper peer universe. Lipper calculated each fund's net total return for the year ended December 31, 2024, minus the effects of 12b-1 fees and sales charges. Each fund in the survey was given a percentile ranking with 100 the highest and 1 the lowest in its category. That ranking measured how a fund compared with its peer "universe," as tracked by Lipper, not just the funds in the survey. Individual fund scores were then multiplied by the 2024 weighting of their Barron's ranking category as determined by the entire Lipper universe of funds. Those fund scores were then totaled, creating an overall score and ranking for each fund family in the survey in each Barron's ranking category. The process is repeated for the five- and ten-year rankings as well.

The Fund may also invest directly in derivatives. **As of December 31, 2024, the Multi-Asset Balanced Opportunity Fund maintained the derivative positions (measured by net notional amounts as a percentage of total fund assets): S&P 500 E-Mini Futures (-1.0%), MSCI EAFE E-Mini Futures (1.0%), Russell 1000 Growth Futures (12.0%).** The Fund's portfolio is actively managed and therefore, its percentage allocations may change from time to time. Holdings are for informational purposes only and are not a recommendation to buy, sell, or hold any security. As of March 31, 2025, the Fund's allocation to cash is 0.2%.
