

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

Weighted Average Market Capitalization is the average market capitalization of all companies held in the portfolio, with each company weighted according to its percent held in the portfolio.

Price/Earnings Ratio is the weighted average of each holding's P/E ratio (price of a stock divided by its earnings per share). The Russell Microcap® Growth Index measures the performance of those Russell Microcap companies with higher price-to-book ratios and higher forecasted growth values

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
